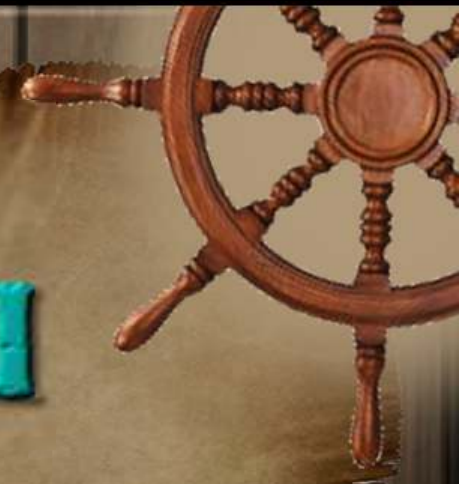


Worship is to be Respectful
