The Roman Helmet

and are saved.**

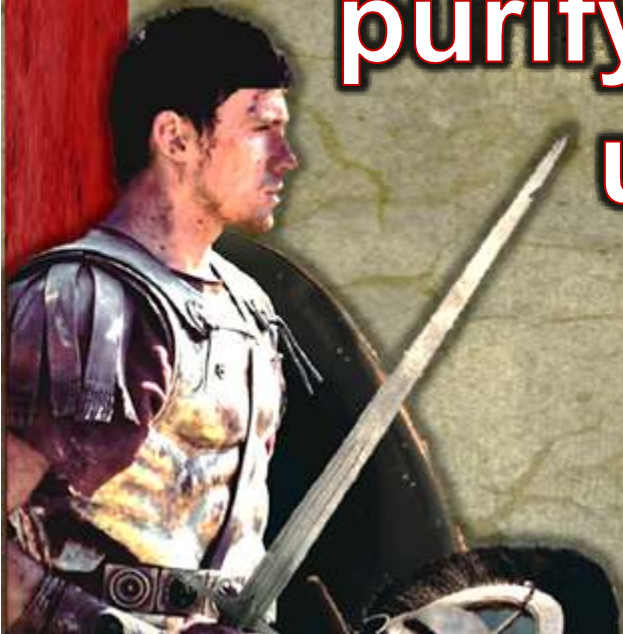
