WHO WAS BARABBAS?


(Barabbas had been thrown into prison for an insurrection in the city, and for murder.)

against God**

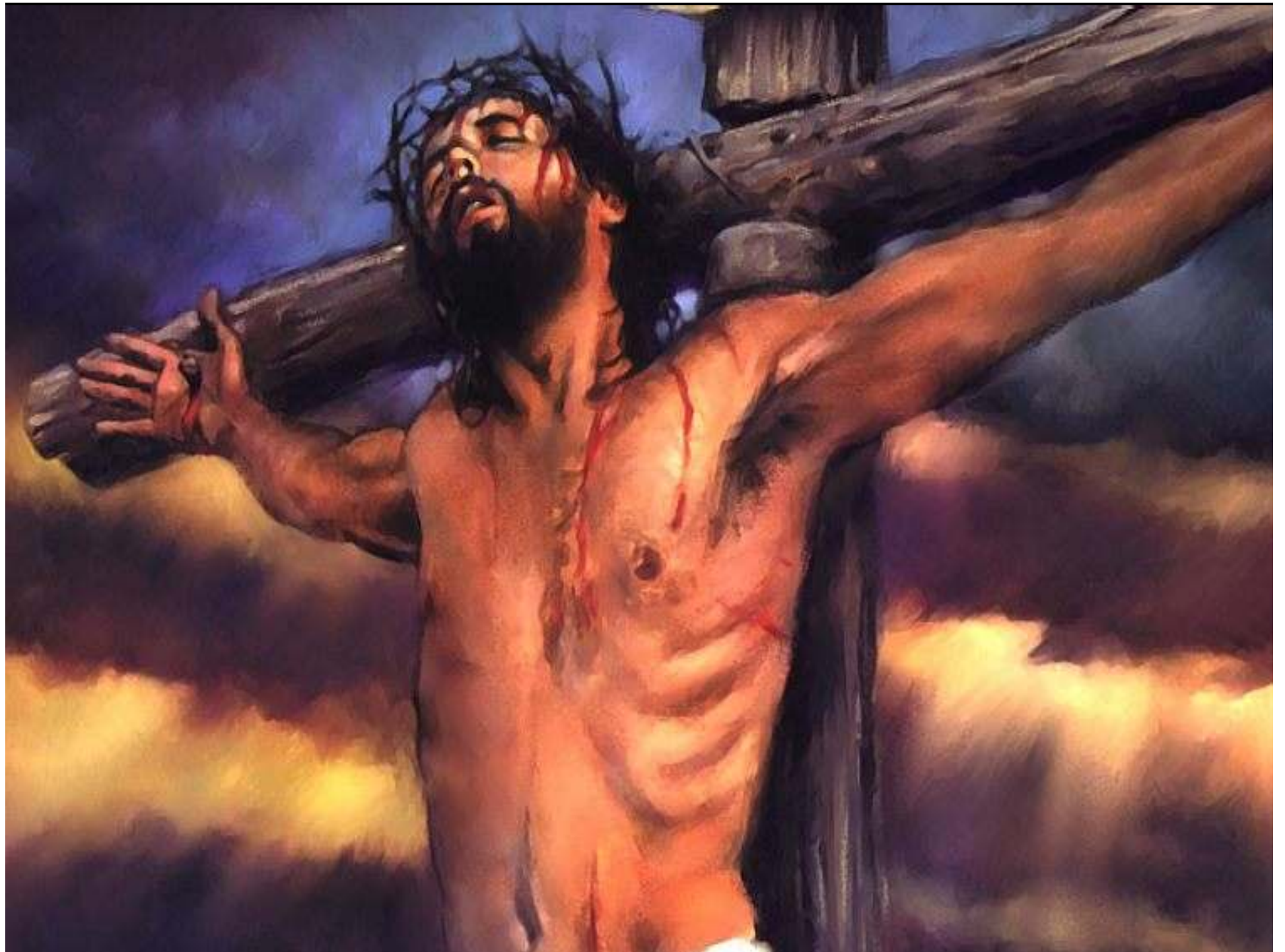
Sentenced to death
