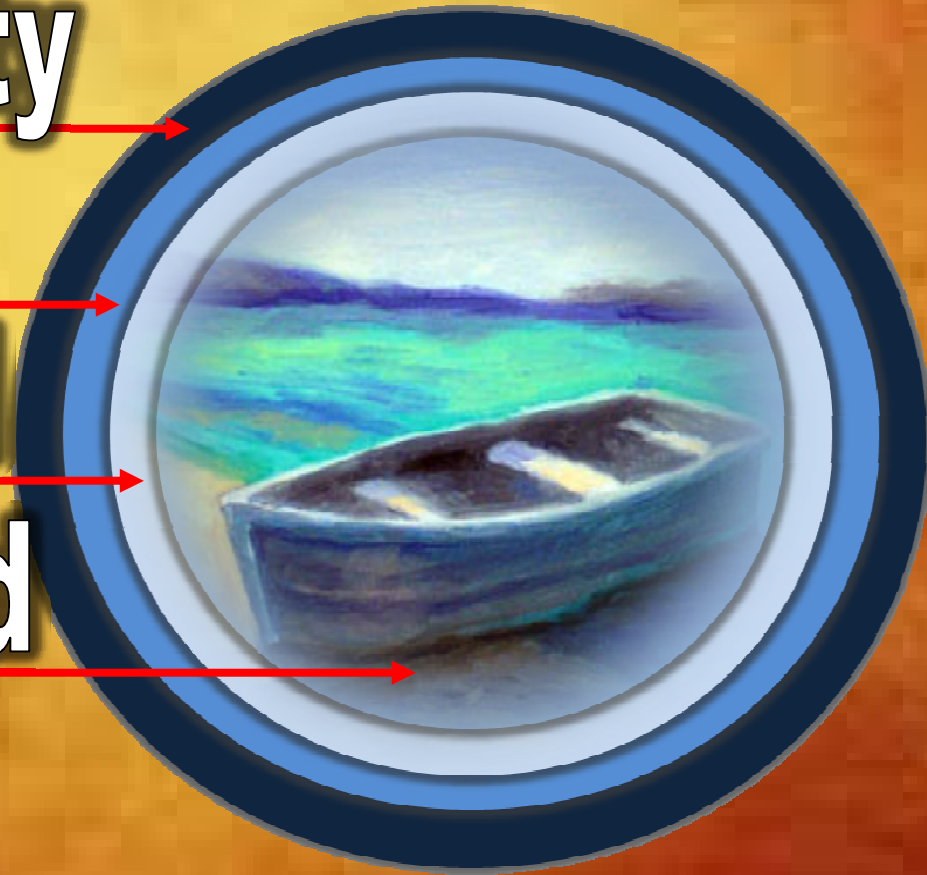

**Some people require a constant flow
of encouragement**

**These are people that run hot or cold
Their encouragement has to come in
short constant bursts**
