Popularity

Defined: liked, admired, or enjoyed by many people or by a particular person or group

The problem arises when the choices you make to achieve popular begin to impact your purpose

Purpose

Defined: the reason for which something is done or created or for which something exists. **Our Purpose: Our Purpose is to** give glory to God by meeting people where they are, sharing Jesus with them in a meaningful way, and encouraging them to live in a growing relationship with Him.

What About Me the Individual ... to live in a growing relationship with Him

The Choice: Living for the approval of people can keep you from the purpose of God

Moses chose option 2 Why?

His value system was right side up! He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.

Choice 1: Moses Chose not to be a consumer He saw all the "things" that went with mom 1 as fleeting Make no mistake they were fun (pleasure) But he realized they would not last He understood they would put him on an endless path of living for the next big thing

Being a consumer is Addictive

Choice 2: Moses Chose to invest in the better value Everybody is looking for return on investment We want bang for our buck (or time) This is what makes Moses' choice awesome He saw the value in following God

Choice 3: Moses Chose to live for tomorrow instead of today Yuk!
