

Understanding the Relationship

If you want to know the father look at the son (John 10:30)

Watching Jesus is like watching the father (John 14:7)

Thus if we stay in Jesus' Shadow and He is in God's shadow then ultimately we are living in our Father's shadow (John 14:20)

The Ministry of Jesus Summed Up!

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

Unlike the temple in the Old Testament, where the presence of God resided, a church building is just a tool to help us in our mission


To compare a church building to the temple is incorrect





Teaching in their synagogues

Synagogues: The building where a Jewish assembly or congregation meets for religious worship and instruction

At a minimum, a synagogue is a be a "house of prayer"

A place of Study

Most synagogues also have a social hall for religious and non-religious activities
