

The Shadow

Defined: A dark area or shape produced by a body coming between rays of light and a surface

Two Things to Exist! A solid object that either absorbs or reflects light A light source

The result is an outlined image of the object opposite the light shining on the object

Living in the Shadow

It's the idea of positioning yourself behind the object so that you do not produce a shadow

In essence your shadow is absorbed into the objects shadow

The Issue

"The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few" The good: The Harvest is Plentiful The bad: The workers are few That which could be harvested and saved dies on the vine That which could be used for the master useless The work that was done to produce the crop is waisted

Because the harvest also produces the seed for the next crop, either there is less harvest in the future or working the field becomes more expensive

Not a New Problem Even back then there was a resource problem Attendance: Not a problem because we are reaping the harvest **Budget Issues:** Not a problem, its simple math, bringing in more people committed to following means their financial resources come with them Service Issues: Gone more people means more servants **Contention in the Church: Stops because** honestly busy people just don't have time

Do What? Ask (Pray) Defined: Request someone to do or give something Matthew 6:8 Matthew 7:7-8 Matthew 21:22 1 John 5:14 John 14:13 John 16:24

Jesus is telling us to make a specific ask

Ask Who? "The Lord of the Harvest" Lord of Healing Lord of Worship Lord of Fellowship **Lord of Discipleship**

The Harvest – It's About People

Don't you have a saying, 'It's still four months until harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest. Even now the one who reaps draws a wage and harvests a crop for eternal life, so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together. Thus the saying 'One sows and another reaps' is true. I sent you to reap what you have not worked for. Others have done the hard work, and you have reaped the benefits of their labor."

The Harvest – It's About Priority But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

That his "main" teaching to the apostles were about going

That his two direct charges to the church after his resurrection were about the harvest Ask for What? To send out workers into his harvest field The request is not send us people it is to send out workers Note the owner of the field --- His field Its a call for God's people to get busy reaping a harvest from His field

What are we really asking for?

What you are really saying is.... (Isaiah 6:8) Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

You are not asking for volunteers (How), you are just asking for direction (Compass) because the moment you pray this, you just volunteered to go!

What are we really asking for? The moment I see it (Harassed and Helpless) The moment I allow my heart to break for it (Compassion) The moment I ask send somebody



God's answer will most likely be... How About You?

Two Ways to Destroy the Shadow Take out the object creating it

Turn out the light (Matthew 5:14-16) "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.
