

Are You Interested in Praying Is the only time you eat when we plan a church fellowship meal

> Is the only time you worship on Sundays at 10:30AM

Is the only time you open God's word during Sunday School or Corporate Study

If prayer becomes nothing more than some prepackaged church ministry with a label stuck on it that we feel some obligation to attend then.

We are solving the wrong problem!

This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

Matthew 6:9-13

"Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" Why start here with prayer? What exactly are we praying for here? Did Jesus really mean that we are to seek heaven on earth? It has to tie back to something we are to seek It has to be something that is beneficial? to Tray

Lord Teach Us The Kingdom and God's Will "Kingdom of Heaven" not a synonym for heaven We aren't talking about a kingdom in the "physical" sense Kingdom: a country, state, or territory ruled by a king or queen to Tray

Finding the Kingdom of Heaven God is the ruler (Revelation 11:15) The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever."

Lord Teach Us **Finding the Kingdom of Heaven** It's centered on repentance (Matthew 4:17) From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

Lord Teach Us Finding the Kingdom of Heaven The way to the kingdom is the more valuable than all your possessions combined For a time both believers and unbelievers are in the kingdom of heaven At some point the unbelievers will be separated out It started small and grows big It values humility over status All are invited to come and those that to Tray don't are with out excuse

Putting the Pieces Together

The kingdom of heaven began at Pentecost with arrival of the Holy Spirit and the beginning of the church.

Where we are today the kingdom is in a growth mode where the church is to be actively seeking the lost and encouraging them toward repentance through a relationship with Christ

Putting the Pieces Together

At some point the kingdom with enter a time of harvest where those that have placed their faith in him will continue that relationship eternally.

The Kingdom of Heaven is all about the Salvation of Humanity

Lord Seach Us God's Will The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

2 Peter 3:9

to Fray

Lord Teach Us God's Will God's will is that none perish He wants everybody to choose a relationship with him He has made promises to those that do But he is also waiting patiently for those promises to be ultimately fulfilled hoping others will come to Ira

Application: What are we praying for?

We are NOT praying for a speedy return of Jesus

In fact what we should be praying for is more time

We are praying for his "territory" here on earth (the church) to grow ultimately growing his kingdom in heaven to Fray

Application: What are we praying for?

The growth is done by praying for his will to be done (none perish)

We are praying for all to come to the banquet

Notice this is where Jesus started

There is no prayer that is bigger than this one

When we pray this we are asking God to give us a chance to make a difference **Romans 10:14** How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? to Ira

If we are serious about prayer, we will be more serious about reaching the lost
