
and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar and said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself." There was a written notice above him, which read: this is the king of the Jews.







When Jesus looked into his eyes and into his heart, he said good enough for me







Hebrews 12:2








Your Past
