

The Book of Jeremiah The book was indeed written long ago It is desperate times for God's people God's people are living in rebellion There is a lot of images in the book **One final note: This is a straight** laced sermon series

This is not a verse by verse study (52 Chapters long) We get introduced to Jermiah God gives Jeremiah a series of messages to deliver Jeremiah delivers the message **Judah responds (Negatively)** Things begin to unwind EREMIAH

Who is Jeremiah His background (v. 1-3)

The words of Jeremiah son of Hilkiah, one of the priests at Anathoth in the territory of Benjamin. The word of the Lord came to him in the thirteenth year of the reign of Josiah son of Amon king of Judah, and through the reign of Jehoiakim son of Josiah king of Judah, down to the fifth month of the eleventh year of Zedekiah son of Josiah king of Judah, when the people of Jerusalem went into exile.

If you do the math for the entire book they you figure out Jeremiah preached for 46 years Jeremiah is a Levite -- son of Hilkiah, one of the priests at Anathoth isions He lives with in the territory of Benjamin (Levite City) For all intensive purposes he was a preacher's kid This is Jeremiah the person EREMIAH

God has a Plan (v. 1-3)

The word of the Lord came to me, saying, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."

God's Relationship with Jeremiah I formed you I knew you (intimate) I set you apart I appointed you

This is not just His relationship with Jeremiah (Psalm 139:13-16) For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place, when I was woven together in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me EREMIAH were written in your book before one of them came to be.

God's Relationship with Us God formed each of us for a unique purpose lisions He has called us into a relationship with Him (Romans 1:6) God has a plan for you EREMIAH (1 Peter 4:11)

Jeremiah's Response (v.6) Excuses -- Not too different from ours "Alas, Sovereign Lord," I said, "I do not know how to speak; I am too young."

The Real Reason (v. 7-8) But the Lord said to me, "Do not say, 'I am too young.' You must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you and will rescue you," declares the Lord.

Jeremiah's Response (v.6) God Sees through the excuses He knows Jeremiah is afraid Going into to the world is one thing, getting God's people to repent is a lot harder **God's Promise --- Rescue** The Good --- I will not abandon you EREMIAH The Bad --- There will be danger

Jeremiah's Message (v. 9-13) Then the Lord reached out his hand and touched my mouth and said to me, "I have put my words in your mouth. See, today I appoint you over nations and kingdoms to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and to plant." The word of the Lord came to me: "What do you see, Jeremiah?" "I see the branch of an almond tree," I replied. The Lord said to me, "You have seen correctly, for I am watching to see that my word is fulfilled." The word of the Lord came to me again: "What do you see?" "I see a pot that is boiling," I answered. "It is EREMIAH tilting toward us from the north."

The Almond Branch The almond branch is one of the first plants to blossom in the spring However, it is also one of the last to produce fruit God is telling Jeremiah his mission will take patience (Revelation 14:12) This was going to be EREMIAH a long term mission

The Boiling Pot This is a declaration of urgency A boiling pot requires immediate attention Jeremiah's mission would indeed require lisions patience but he must preach with urgency (Ephesians 5:15-16) Be very careful, then, how you live-not as unwise but as wise, 16 making the most of every opportunity, because the days TEREMIAN are evil.

The Application (v. 14-16)

The Lord said to me, "From the north disaster will be poured out on all who live in the land. I am about to summon all the peoples of the northern kingdoms,"

declares the Lord. "Their kings will come and set up their thrones in the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem; they will come against all her surrounding walls and against all the towns of Judah. I will pronounce my judgments on my people because of their wickedness in forsaking me, in burning incense to other gods and in worshiping what their hands have made.

What Next (v. 17-19)

"Get yourself ready! Stand up and say to them whatever I command you. Do not be terrified by them, or I will terrify you before them. Today I have made you a fortified city, an iron pillar and a bronze wall to stand against the whole land against the kings of Judah, its officials, its priests and the people of the land. They will fight against you but will not overcome you, for I am with you and will rescue you," declares the Lord.
