### **Lack of Communication**

A process by which information is exchanged between individuals through a common system of symbols, signs, or behavior

The Symptoms: Yelling, Holding grudges, Keeping secrets, Blaming, Giving the silent treatment, Using ultimatums or threats, Labeling someone bad instead of the behavior and Bringing harm.

Improper communication leads to false Assumptions, Jumping to conclusions, Worrying, Fear and Concern, Stress, Gossip and Lying, Division and Separation
