

The Before

The apostle Paul has been arrested and is headed for trial in Rome

They are on a boat



The boat has encountered a major storm

The crew has now been battling the storm for two weeks

They have done everything in their physical power to keep the boat afloat

Lost Hope

- Hope is the chain that connects to you Soul's Anchor
- When neither sun nor stars appeared for many days and the storm continued raging, we finally gave up all hope of being saved.



v. 20

Life Storms

They are out of options they drop 4 anchors in the water in a last-ditch attempt to try and wait out the storm



Some decide it's time to abandon ship

To prevent the men from leaving they cut the lifeboats free setting them adrift

How can Paul a man headed to trial on board a doomed ship be so calm?



Anchor #1: God's People

The next day we landed at Sidon; and Julius, in kindness to Paul, allowed him to go to his friends so they might provide for his needs.

 God had somebody there to minister to Paul

 Luke was along for the ride. (Us and We)

 Your soul is not designed to face the storm alone

 Other's can absolutely provide stability during a storm

Anchor #2: God's Purpose

After they had gone a long time without food, Paul stood up before them and said: "Men, you should have taken my advice not to sail from Crete; then you would have spared yourselves this damage and loss. But now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost; only the ship will be destroyed. Last night an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I serve stood beside me and said, 'Do not be afraid, Paul. You must stand trial before Caesar; and God has graciously given you the lives of all who sail with you.'

(v. 21-24)

Anchor #3: God's Promise So, keep up your courage, men, for I have faith in God that it will happen just as he told me. Nevertheless, we must run aground on some island."

(v. 25-26)

God did this so that, by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled to take hold of the hope set before us may be greatly encouraged.

Hebrews 6:18

Anchor#4: God's Peace

Just before dawn Paul urged them all to eat. "For the last fourteen days," he said, "you have been in constant suspense and have gone without food—you haven't eaten anything. Now I urge you to take some food. You need it to survive. Not one of you will lose a single hair from his head." After he said this, he took some bread and gave thanks to God in front of them all. Then he broke it and began to eat. They were all encouraged and ate some food themselves. Altogether there were 276 of us on board.

(v. 33-37)
