perform the duties in the Tabernacle**

Personal

**They made an outfit for
each individual Priest**

This was not a one size fits all

**Each priest would have been
measured and fitted**



The Outer Basic Uniform

Profession: Tell all the skilled workers to whom I have given wisdom in such matters that they are to make garments for Aaron

This was not a home sewn costume

Do you see the word (Skill)

It would not be a onetime event

Purposeful -- Dignity and Honor

The Outer Basic Uniform

Purposeful -- Dignity and Honor

When you wear that name Jesus understand you put him on

When you call yourself a Christian that title comes with duties, responsibilities, obligations and even orders

Do not take wearing it lightly

**And be sure to watch how you walk
(Colossians 1:10)**



The Dressing Ceremony

After you put these clothes on your brother Aaron and his sons, anoint, and ordain them. Consecrate them so they may serve me as priests.

We are told putting on these clothes was not just about getting dressed

The entire point of the ceremony and the uniform was to designate the people for service



How May I Serve You?

Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave—just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

How May I Serve You?

The moment you put on Christ you put on servanthood

It uses the word slave: Owned --- Master

You are entitled to nothing more than the privilege of serving in his presence

Does God really care About my Underwear

“Make linen undergarments as a covering for the body, reaching from the waist to the thigh. Aaron and his sons must wear them whenever they enter the tent of meeting or approach the altar to minister in the Holy Place, so that they will not incur guilt and die.

v.42-43



Does God really care About my Underwear

**For most of the duties the priest would shed
their tunic upon entering the Holy Place**

**It was in their underwear they came into
God's presence**

**Unlike the full uniform the only thing covered
was the very private parts**

**This goes back to serving God means we
must be real and vulnerable**



Does God really care About my Underwear

**It shows God is just as concerned about what's
on the inside as he is about what we see**

**No surprise here, man looks on the outside,
man looks at the heart**
