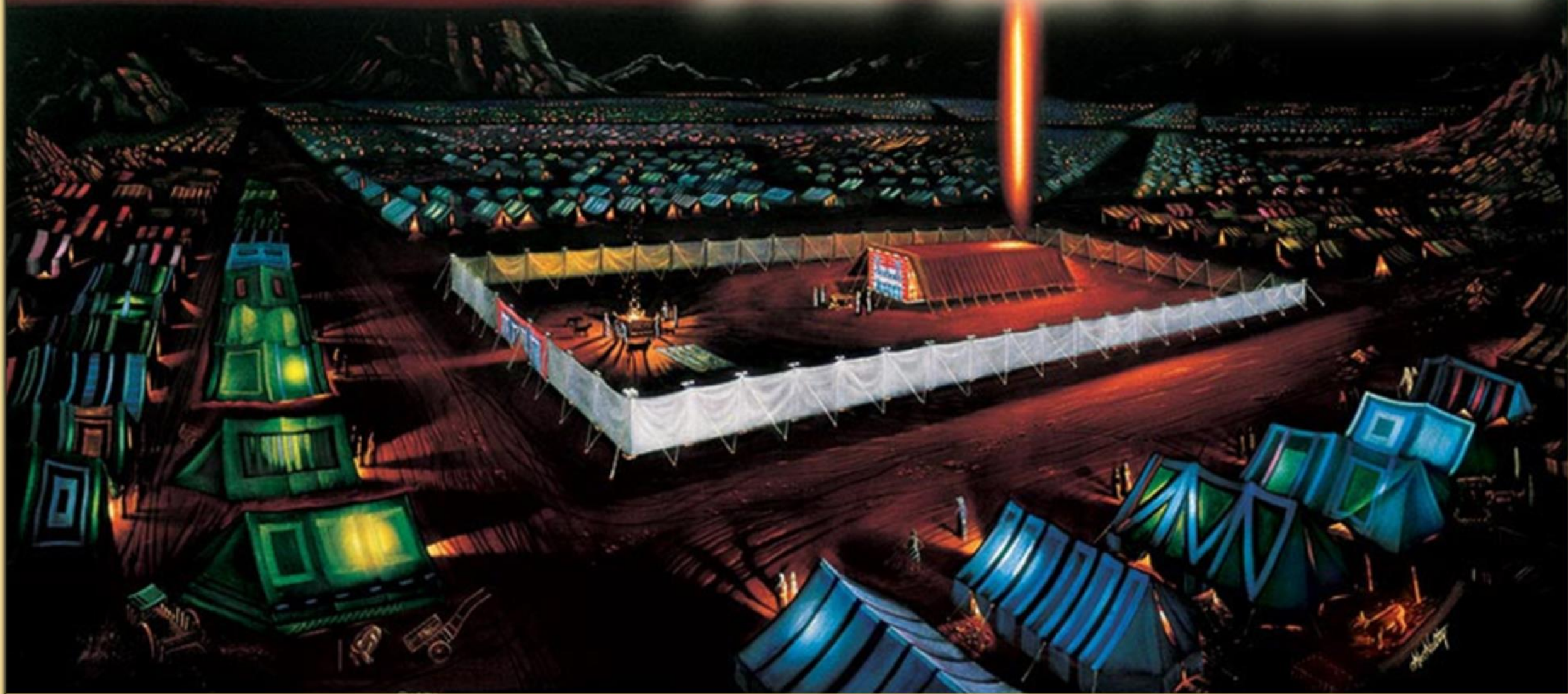

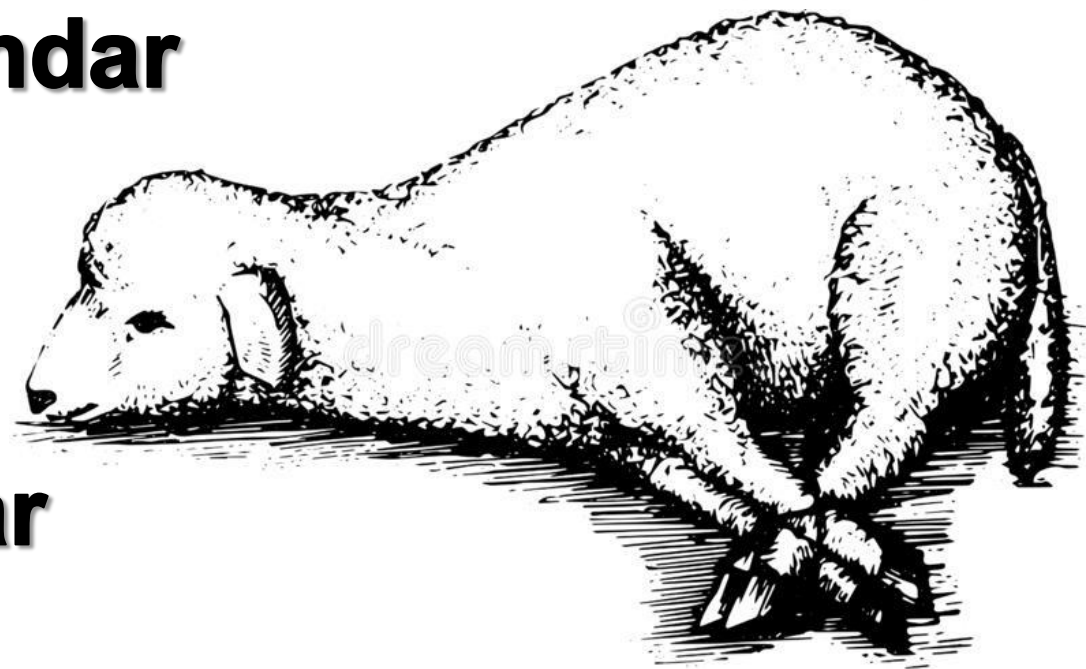

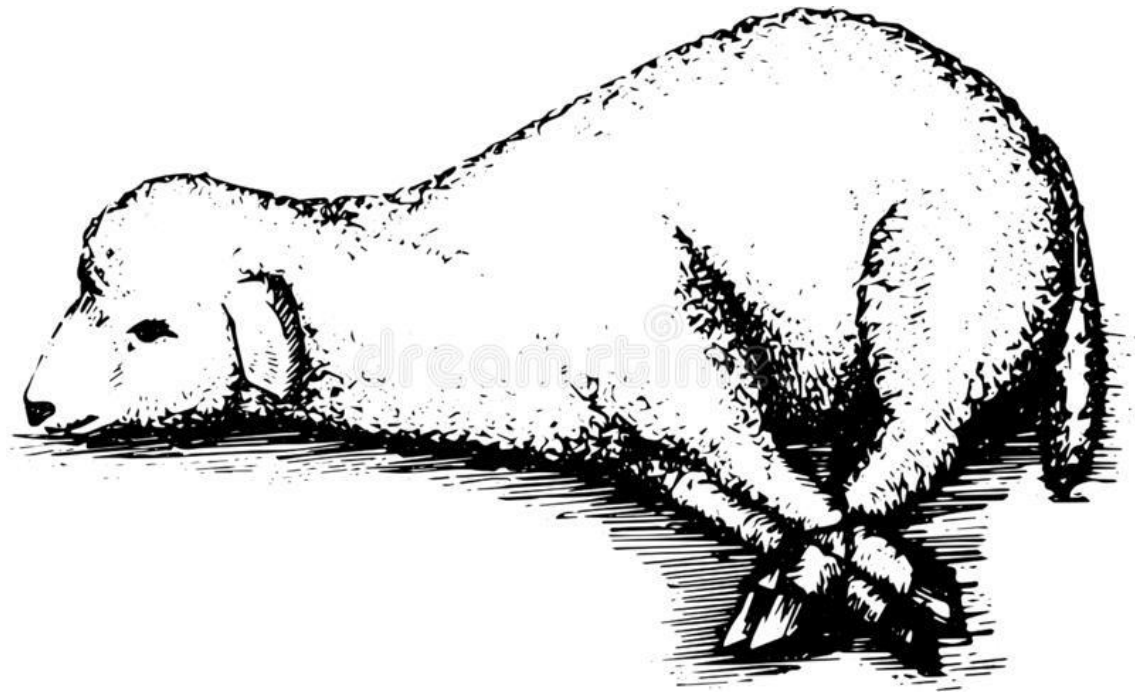

**Sacrifice the Lamb and spread the blood (*Revelation 5:6*)**

**Why?** In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. (*Hebrews 9:22*)



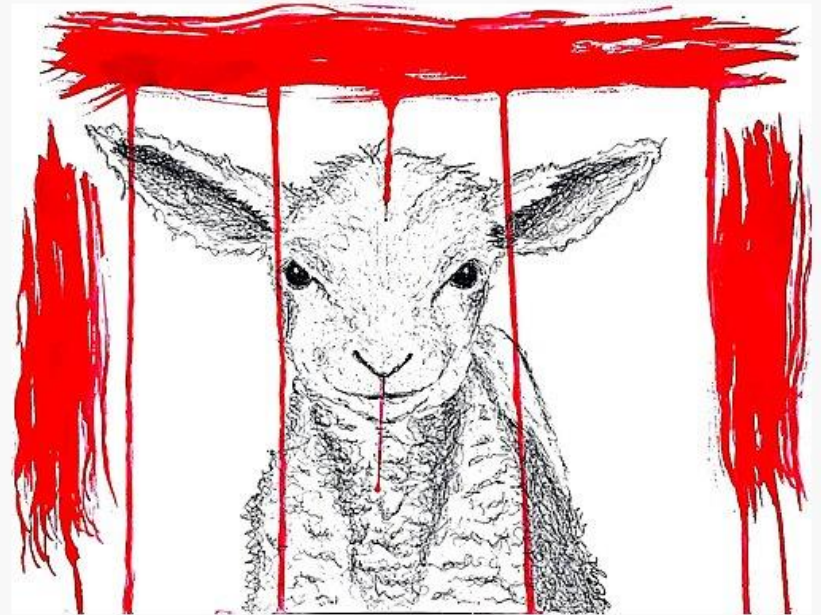
