







## Hearing God's Call Is all about location

The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the house of the Lord, where the ark of God was.

1 Samuel 3:3



Fact 2: The light had not gone out.

Fact 3: Samuel was living in that light.



## Hearing God's Call

#### Means Knowing God's Voice (1 Samuel 3:4-8)

Then the Lord called Samuel. Samuel answered, "Here I am." And he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." But Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down." So, he went and lay down. Again, the Lord called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said,

"Here I am; you called me." "My son," Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down." Now Samuel did not yet know the Lord: The word of the Lord had not yet been revealed to him. A third time the Lord called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." Then

Eli realized that the Lord was calling the boy.

#### Hearing God's Call Means Knowing God's Voice

The Lord had to call Samuel four times

Samuel had never actually heard the voice of God

He did respond he just went to the wrong person



It took the seasoned follower three tries before he could instruct Samuel



## Hearing God's Call It was a Personal Call

God did not ask for a volunteer

He did not say "Hey You!"





He called Samuel by name


While Samuel had not a clue who was calling him, God knew exactly who he was looking for

#### Hearing God's Call It was a Persistent Call

God did just try once and give up on Samuel

When Samuel figured it out, God did not scold him for not getting the first three right.

God, but I also remind you that until it is over, God will not disconnect from you.



# Responding to God's Call Begins with Availability

So, Eli told Samuel, "Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, 'Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." So, Samuel went and lay down in his place. The Lord came and


stood there, calling as at the other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" Then Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

## Responding to God's Call


#### Accepting a Difficult Message

And the Lord said to Samuel: "See, I am about to do something in Israel that will make the ears of everyone who hears about it tingle. At that time, I will carry out against Eli everything I spoke against his family—from beginning to end. For I told him that I would judge

his family forever because of the sin he knew about; his sons blasphemed God, and he failed to restrain them. Therefore, I swore to the house of Eli, 'The guilt of Eli's house will never be atoned for by sacrifice or offering.'" Samuel lay down until morning and then opened the doors of the house of the Lord. He was afraid to tell Eli the vision

#### **Sharing God's Word**

nothing from him. Then Eli said, "He is the Lord;

let him do what is good in his eyes."


