### REMEMBER LOT'S WIFE

By the time Lot reached Zoar, the sun had risen over the land. Then the Lord rained down burning sulfur on Sodom and Gomorrah—from the Lord out of the heavens. Thus, he overthrew those cities and the entire plain, destroying all those living in the cities—and also the vegetation in the land. But Lot's wife looked back, and she became a pillar of salt.

**Genesis 19:23-26** 

## SHE LOOKED BACK!

With the coming of dawn, the angels urged Lot, saying, "Hurry! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away when the city is punished."

v. 15

God had sent messengers to deliver her family from destruction, but she looked back

She escaped with her family and her life, but she looked back

## Why Look BACK?

Like Lot's wife God sent somebody into our lives to rescue us from certain destruction

You have been rescued (Galatians 5:3-5)

And you are commanded to flee. (2 Timothy 2:22)

Maybe we have much more in common with Lot's wife then we think

## Why Look Bask?

When he hesitated, the men grasped his hand and the hands of his wife and of his two daughters and led them safely out of the city, for the Lord was merciful to them. As soon as they had brought them out, one of them said, "Flee for your lives! Don't look back, and don't stop anywhere in the plain! Flee to the mountains or you will be swept away!"



It always begins with leadership

She looked back, however, it was Lot that refused to move forward

It says he hesitated

What if he had boldly led his family instead of being pulled from his "life" kicking and screaming

Lot's hesitation added to his wife's doubt



I don't think we take God at his word

The verse says He is a merciful God

He wouldn't really allow anybody to actually be sent to Hell?

He's a forgiving God He really would not punish for something as small as looking back?
