



# THE BETTS

Religion: A cause, principle, or system of beliefs held to with ardor and faith

### Jesus and the Daw


Jesus did not do away with the law (Matthew 5:17)


He was not throwing out the rules


He also points out to respect what they are teaching


However, beware of following their actions for they do not practice what they preach
