Devoted


The act of dedicating something to a cause, enterprise, or activity

Exclusively allocated to or intended for a particular service or purpose




When you make your plans do things have to fit around "church" or does "church" have to fit around things?

It's What God Rewards




Eagerly

Marked by enthusiastic or impatient desire or interest




Enthusiasm breeds Enthusiasm
