


The focus is taken off God


Worship becomes connection via receiving not giving

## Simple Worship "The Breaking of Bread"

While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and they all drank from it. "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many," he said to them.

The purposeful part is that it is a time of evaluating my relationship with Jesus (1 Corinthians 11:23-28)

# Simple Worship "Praising God"


It does not specifically say music (Psalm 149:1)

You can praise him with body motion. (Psalm 134:2)

You can shout (Psalm 71:23)

You can praise in prayer (Isaiah 63:7)





### Simple Worship "It's Not About the How"

Praise the Lord. Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens. Praise him for his acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness. Praise him with the sounding of the trumpet, praise him with the harp and lyre, praise him with timbrel and dancing, praise him with the strings and pipe, praise him with the clash of cymbals, praise him with resounding cymbals. Let everything that has breath praise the Lord.
