The name Noah derives from Noach, a Hebrew name meaning "REST"

He named him Noah and said, "He will **comfort** us in the **labor** and **painful toil of our hands caused by the ground** the Lord has cursed."

The Sons of Noah

After Noah was 500 years old, he became the father of Shem, Ham and Japheth

Genesis 5:32

Noah is 500 when these three came along thus it is mostly likely he had other kids before these

That means while three of his sons, his wife and their wives got on the ark Noah most likely left many offspring



The Sons of Noah

The short answer is they are the only ones that decided to get on the ark thus all the others died

**Noah was 600-year-old when he entered the ark
(Genesis 7:6)**

God decide on the flood 120 years prior to the first rain drop. (Genesis 6:3)



The Sons of Noah

The boys were born to Noah and his wife 20 years after the countdown started.

What's the Big Deal?

These boys would have spent their entire life, **Hearing** about the pending flood, **Watching** and eventually **helping** on the construction of the ark. **Wrestling** with a world out of control with sin

Noah's World

The Bigger Problem

The Bigger Problem
