Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.

One Lord



The Bible references Jesus as Lord over 100 times

He is directly refenced as Savior only 23 times

Of those 23, several of the verses combine the word Lord with savior

Salvation is Conditional on Lordship

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:9

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

Matthew 7:21

Salvation is Conditional on Lordship

Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness."

It is because Lordship means giving 2 Timothy 2:19 up control: someone or something having power, authority, or influence; a master or ruler.

Jesus is God

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage

Jesus is God the Son and is God (John 1:1)

It means he was not a created being but rather the creator (John 1:2-3)

Philippians 2:5-6

Jesus is Identifiable

He made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

Philippians 2:7

Jesus is 100% God, however, he is also 100% human

When God put his plan in motion to redeem humanity taking on humanity was always part of the plan

He was not just God in human form, he was God wrapped in humanity

Jesus is Identifiable

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.

Hebrews 4:15

Jesus did not just need human flesh to sacrifice he chose to be human from cradle (manger) to cross, into the grave and beyond (He still has his humanity)

Jesus is Sacrificial

And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross!

Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing at the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders. The Lamb had seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

Revelation 5:6

Jesus is Sacrificial

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

John 1:29

And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Hebrews 10:10

Jesus is Sacrificial

The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life—only to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father."

John 10:17-18

That sacrifice makes him worth to be Lord (Revelation 5:11-12)

Jesus is Already Lord

Therefore, God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 2:9-11

Jesus is Already Lord

In this future tense verse, they are not making Jesus Lord, they are proclaiming what is already true

There is no exception of his Lordship

Every Knee will bow

Every tongue will confess

Perhaps in the defiant recesses of our mind we think not me, I shall never bow and I will never submit

Jesus is Already Lord

Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, saying: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!" The four living creatures said, "Amen," and the elders fell down and worshiped.

Revelation 5:13-14
