What is Unity?

Unity is not conformity

It does not mean we have to agree on everything

Unity also is not proximity

Nor is Unity Commonality

When we talk "unity" it is really about oneness

Oneness

The fact or state of being unified or whole, though comprised of two or more parts

Oneness acknowledges our differences
While at the same time pointing out our
dependency

Oneness

If you are sitting here today and consider yourself a Christ follower (Christian) he is talking about you

You are here because of the message and sacrifice of those whom we call the apostles

As great and complete as Jesus' sacrifice was if these men whom he chose did not do their mission, the world would look a lot different today

He does not pray that we be godly, he asks that we be godlike
