Moses was born an Israelite but was adopted by Pharoh's daughter


While he we being raised Egyptian, his mom got to raise him

God circles back and encourages Moses that together, they've got this



Jesus left his people to come to his people to offer freedom from the slavery of sin (*Romans 7:25*)




Moses did exactly what God asked him to do
