Looking for the Lost

the gift from Jesus





Acceptance Starts with Acknowledging I Am Lost

If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

Romans 10:9–10

Acceptance Starts with Acknowledging I Am Lost

Acceptance Starts with Acknowledging I Am Lost

What does life look like once you've been found by Jesus?

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

Romans 6:4

**I did not just desire to be found,
I had been found, making the next step
clear: following the One who came
looking for me.**

Following Jesus

Baptism is not about understanding every detail

It's about identifying with the story that rescued you

He was not looking for a godly person, a good person, or a righteous person, just a lost person

Following in baptism meant, I was choosing to step into the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus; His story intersecting my story

“I'm leaving my old life and stepping into a new one.”

Following Jesus

What does it mean to truly follow the One who found me?

For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.”

Romans 1:17

Salvation leads somewhere. Found people follow someone. And following someone is how you arrive at the somewhere

Following is what shows I belong to the One who found me

Following Jesus

Following Jesus isn't perfection, it's direction
